1. **Melancholy** - has an unquenchable thirst for knowledge, prone to genius, very creative, mind tends to work overtime, going over and over events of the past, needs alone time to regenerate, introvert, always seeking knowledge and wisdom, ability to see the end of a task or situation before they begin. Fear of the unknown causes them to procrastinate.
2. **Sanguine** - fun, loving, will leave in the middle of a chore or assignment if they find out there is something fun going on somewhere, never wants to grow up, stressed out if there are not places to go and people to see.
3. **Choleric** - a drive to greatness, but will stomp on your toes to get there, needs lots of appreciation along the way. Sharp and keen insight, quick and intuitive in accomplishing task, they have a great need for control and recognition.
